Art Center Welcomes Visiting Art Instructors

Jan 9 (pm), 10, 11 -- SAM KATES, St. Augustine, FL --

Acrylic Painting Workshop: Workshop will begin with a demo on Sunday, Jan 9, 1-5 pm. Sunday Salon participants will be invited to watch during the last two hours of the demo session. On Monday, depending on the tides and weather, we will go outdoors for a sketch session, then paint Monday afternoon and all day Tuesday. The workshop will end with a critique session.

Feb 6 (pm), 7, 8 -- REDENTA SOPRANO, Winter Park, FL --

Botanical Illustration Workshop: This workshop will explore the plant kingdom with its fascinating diversity of form. Give yourself some quality time to really enjoy the beauty of flowers by learning to draw and paint them realistically. Emphasis will be on accuracy and creating a 3-D effect by shading with graphite pencil & rendering your drawing with layers of watercolor. Experienced or beginning artists welcome. Demo on Sunday, Feb 6, 1-5 pm. Sunday Salon participants will be invited to watch during the last two hours of the demo. Monday and Tuesday will include further demos and hands on instruction.

Air Pastel: Join experienced pastel artist, Ray Hassard, who will be visiting Cedar Key during a trip to Florida. On Sunday afternoon, 1-5pm Ray will discuss the "how to's" of Plein Air Painting with workshop participants and do a demo with the Salon Group (3-5 pm). On Monday the workshop will pick an outdoor spot to work, weather permitting. Whether you are new to pastels and plein air painting or just want to join other plein air artists for a day of hands on instruction, this should be a fantastic workshop.

Beach, FL -- Conversations in Oil: Learn to listen to those inner thoughts. What do you ask yourself when you are painting?
