Entry Fee: \$ 5.00 entry fee/entry, max of 3 pieces per artist, max fee \$10 (2 or 3 entries). NOTE: Entry Fees will be waived for artists who participated in the 2020 OFCA Design Contest Competition.

- *This is your opportunity to share what you love about our special corner of the world.*
- *Entries must be original works and consistent with the theme (In Love with Cedar Key).*
- *Wall artwork must be ready to hang.*
- *Unprofessional presentations will not be accepted.*
- *Accepted work should remain on exhibit until March 2, unless purchased by visitor leaving the Cedar Key area before the end of the show. NOTE: no sales will be processed on March 1 & 2 for this exhibit.*
- *Any work sold in connection with the exhibit or because of the exhibit is to be handled through the Cedar Keyhole (75% to artist, 25% to Cedar Key Arts Center).*

Prizes: \$100, \$50 and \$25 will be awarded based on adherence to the theme & quality of the work.
